- Interacts with vendors, other agencies, and other client staff on behalf of the client.
- Coordinates development of deliverables and products.
- Ensures quality assurance of AWS project deliverables.
- Maintains current knowledge of AWS cloud technology and solutions.
- Participates in special projects as required.
- Leads AWS cloud process improvement initiatives, such as cloud customer onboarding, change management, configuration management, AWS self service solutions.
